Bus bay extension on Spit Road at Parriwi Road

The bus stop re-opened to customers in May and the final landscaping and concrete work is now complete. We will return for one more night shift to complete the final line marking **between 6pm and 5am on Wednesday 1 July**. If the night shift is cancelled due to rain, we will aim to move it to another night within seven days. The crews will then tidy up and move out of the area.

We thank you for your patience while we extended the bus bay, which will improve the reliability of bus services, traffic flow and journey times along Spit Road.

New bus bay on Military Road opposite Prince Street

The bus stop and new bus bay will open to customers on **Sunday 28 June**. From this date, the citybound bus stop located on Military Road near Belmont Road will be relocated 70m north to the new bus bay at Prince Street. Customers will need to catch the bus from Prince Street moving forward.

Some remaining work including asphaltting, landscaping, line marking, concrete pours for the new footpath and tidying up the site will be completed in July.

Hours of work

Most construction activity will occur between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

For improved safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic, we will need to work up to four night shifts **between 6pm and 5am across Wednesday 1, Thursday 2, Monday 13, Tuesday 14, Wednesday 22 and Thursday 23 July**. If a night shift is cancelled due to rain, we will aim to move it to another night in that same week.

We plan to complete the final asphaltting work on **Wednesday 1 July**, which unfortunately will be very noisy and will continue throughout the night as the work must be finished in one shift, ready for traffic the next morning. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

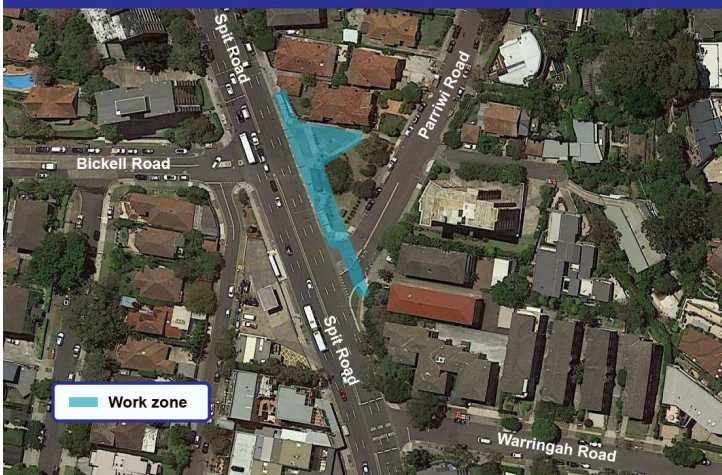
Minimising community impact

Some of the work may be noisy and we will do everything we can to minimise disruption, including:

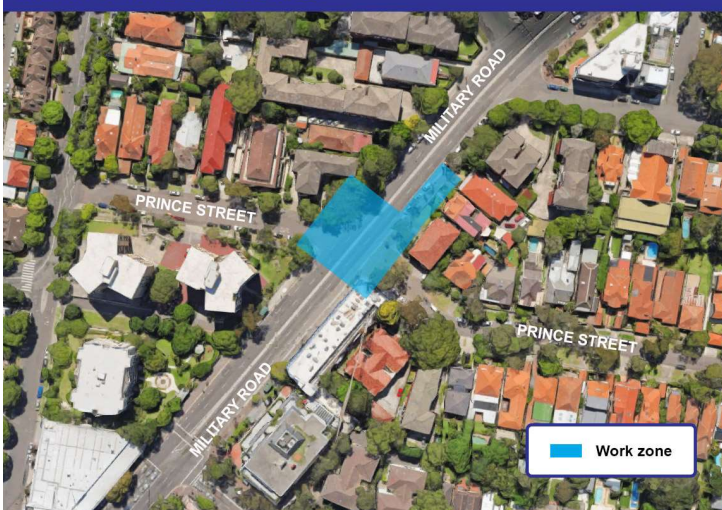
- letting residents know what to expect before the work starts
- using barriers, sound blankets and squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles to reduce noise
- only using noisy machinery when necessary
- doing noisy work early in the evening when possible
- directing the noise and lights away from residents where possible.
