



# New Intercity Fleet Maintenance Facility

## EXTENDED TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

We are delivering a New Intercity Fleet to replace the trains carrying customers from Sydney to the Central Coast, Newcastle, the Blue Mountains and the South Coast.

The detailed design and construction of the new maintenance facility at Kangy Angy, which will service and maintain the New Intercity Fleet, is being delivered by John Holland on behalf of Transport for NSW.

### Temporary road closure - Turpentine and Ourimbah roads

#### Extended to Friday 10 July

Work to resurface and re-align the road at the intersection of Turpentine and Ourimbah roads has been extended by one week. This work is now expected to be complete by **6pm Friday 10 July**. John Holland apologise for any inconvenience caused.

### Temporary road closure - Turpentine Road underpass

#### From Saturday 11 July

Following the completion of the intersection work, a temporary road closure will be in place on Turpentine Road at the rail bridge underpass from **7am Saturday 11 July for around three days**, weather permitting, to allow for the completion of drainage upgrades.

This closure may be brought forward if the intersection work is completed ahead of schedule. Nearby residents will be notified in advance of any change.

Work will be undertaken during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Sunday, including public holidays**. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified if work is required outside of these construction hours.

### Temporary traffic diversions

During the intersection work, access to Enterprise Drive will remain available via Turpentine Road or via the new access bridge off Orchard Road (*refer to map overleaf*). Access to private driveways will not be impacted. Pedestrian access will be restricted during the work. Traffic controllers will be in place as required during heavy vehicle movements. Please follow the direction of signs and traffic controllers.

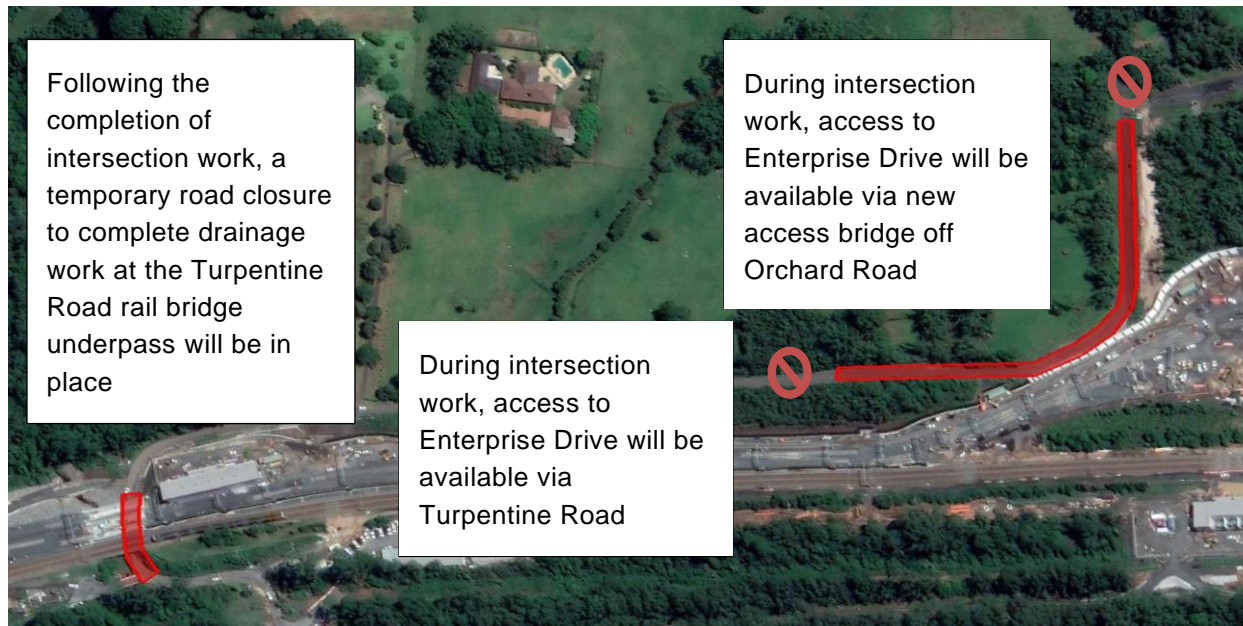
If the Turpentine underpass becomes inaccessible during a period of heavy rain, John Holland will provide escorted access to residents through the worksite.

## Equipment

The following equipment will be used:

- Road profiling equipment
- Asphalt laying plant
- Excavator
- Trucks
- Hand tools
- Line marking machinery

The work will be noisy at times and we will aim to minimise noise by turning off equipment when not in use and facing machinery away from residences where possible.
