The Wollstonecraft Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Site investigations

Site investigations and survey work will be completed from 8am to 6pm on Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 March 2020. The results of the investigations will be used to inform the concept design for the Wollstonecraft Station Upgrade.

The work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when train services will not operate. For further information on rail replacement buses, phone **131500** or visit transportnsw.info.

Equipment to be used

The work will include the use of generators and hand tools, survey tools, hi-rail vacuum truck, drills and testing equipment.

Measures will be used to reduce noise including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Standard working hours

Standard work hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays.

We will notify the community before any work outside standard work hours.
