COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Transport for NSW is upgrading electrical infrastructure as part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program, which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains.

Upcoming work

Between 7am and 6pm, Wednesday 19 to Friday 21 August, temporary site facilities and materials will be delivered into an area beside the rail tracks via the rail gates on Hartley Road and Terminus Road. Seven Hills.

Machinery and equipment will also be delivered and removed from the rail corridor **between 6pm and 6am, Wednesday 19 to Wednesday 26 August.** Trucks will temporarily stop in the Kiss and Ride area on Terminus Road for up to ten minutes to unload machinery and equipment. Traffic controllers will safely guide motorists and pedestrians around the equipment.

Weekend work

Work will be carried out on the rail tracks between Blacktown Station and Seven Hills Station from midnight Friday 21 to midnight Sunday 23 August to install new overhead wires and structures, and remove redundant overhead wires.

Tree trimming will occur adjacent to the tracks (subject to approval). Access to the rail corridor will be via the rail gates on Hartley Road and Terminus Road, Seven Hills.

To ensure the safety of our customers and staff, this work will be completed during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. Train services will be affected during weekend work.

Construction equipment

Equipment to be used includes chainsaws, cherry pickers, cranes, crane trucks, winches, lighting towers, work vehicles, and various hand and power tools.

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are managed effectively.
