Project overview

The Ourimbah Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Ourimbah Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Weekend work – Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 July 2020

With construction work starting in the coming months, preliminary investigation work will be carried out from **7am to 7pm** on Saturday 25 and Sunday 26 July 2020 (weather permitting) during a scheduled trackwork weekend, when train services don't operate and the station is closed.

Activities to be undertaken on 25 and 26 July include:

- using a small drilling rig for geotechnical investigations of the ground conditions (predominantly within the rail corridor and the platform)
- surveying the existing platform, station buildings and surrounding areas
- installing site sheds, fencing and hoarding (within the rail corridor)
- locating electrical services.

Equipment to be used includes mini piling rigs, vacuum excavation trucks, delivery trucks, power and hand tools.

The construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by this important work.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm, Saturdays.

We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Temporary traffic, access and parking changes

During our work, there may be temporary traffic and access changes surrounding Ourimbah Station. Changes may include single lane road closures and/or temporary parking reduction to accommodate large vehicles and to enable removal of rock/spoil from the work areas.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with all changes.
