Upcoming work

Construction on the Ourimbah Station Upgrade is progressing well with site establishment and investigation activities underway during September.

Activities will continue in October and include the construction of lift well foundations. Equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, piling rigs, trucks, excavators, mobile crane, power and hand tools.

Temporary changes to Shirley Street commuter car park

From **7am Saturday 3 October** until **5pm Sunday 4 October 2020**, up to **10 parking spaces** near the station building within the Shirley Street commuter car park will be **closed** to ensure the safety of our workers and customers during work on the October long weekend. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the temporary traffic and parking changes.

Night work – 29 September and 1 October 2020

In preparation for work on the October long weekend, night work will be carried out between **8pm and 4am** on **Tuesday 29 September 2020**. The work will involve delivering equipment to site and delivering and placing materials in the Memorial Garden. There will be a temporary lane closure on Pacific Highway (southbound) near Ourimbah Station while this work is carried out.

Work will be carried out in the Memorial Garden from Wednesday 30 September to construct a temporary platform for a piling rig to operate during the October long weekend. Equipment to be used includes an excavator, delivery trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

Following this, a second temporary lane closure on Pacific Highway (southbound) between **8pm and 4am** on **Thursday 1 October 2020** will occur to deliver a piling rig to the Memorial Garden.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to help motorists with the temporary traffic changes.

Protective hoarding will be installed around the cenotaph while work is carried out and the grass will be replaced at the end of the work on the October long weekend.

Weekend work – 3-6 October 2020

To ensure the safety of customers and workers, work will be carried out during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend. Work will be carried out **continuously** from **6am Saturday 3 October** to **2am Tuesday 6 October 2020**.

During the October long weekend the station will be closed as train services do not operate.

Access to the footbridge from both commuter car parks will remain open. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians and temporary fencing will be used to divert pedestrians through the construction zones safely.

The work will involve operation of a large mobile crane and piling rig within the commuter car park, rail corridor and the Memorial Garden to install foundation piles at the lift wells and deliver equipment and fencing to the platforms. One tree will be removed in the Memorial Garden (immediately south of the footbridge) to allow for construction of the new lift. Work will also be carried out to install a temporary ramp within the Shirley Street commuter car park. See the map overleaf for more information.

Other equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

Traffic controllers will assist pedestrians using the footbridge while the crane intermittently operates between **7am and 3pm** on **Saturday 3 October 2020**. The stairs to Platform 1 will be closed during the weekend work.

The construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work. All piling activities will take place during daytime hours to reduce noise and vibration impact.
