The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Parkes Station

This project is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a Transport for NSW initiative which aims to provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Key features of the proposed concept design include:

- upgrades to the existing accessible car space and kiss and ride space
- new ambulant toilets and a family accessible toilet
- upgrades to existing footpaths
