



# Redfern Station Upgrade

## New Southern Concourse

### COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

November - December 2020

The Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams and customers with luggage. The New Southern Concourse will improve accessibility to public transport and help people move around the growing area and is the first step in the renewal of the Redfern North Eveleigh Precinct.

### November and December update

Work continues at Redfern Station to inform the design of the station upgrade including services searching, investigation work and saw cutting of the platform areas prior to weekend work.

**In November and December**, you may notice personnel accessing 125 – 127 Little Eveleigh Street. Investigation work is required within the building as part of the design process.

### Upcoming weekend and night work

Some weekend work will also occur in November and December during scheduled trackwork weekends. The table below provides up-to-date details about this work.

Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 November	5am to 6pm  6am to 8pm	Platforms 1, 2, 3 and 4	Excavate cable routes within the platforms and install conduits.  Excavation to identify services within the platforms.  Backfill and compact the excavated areas.  Adjust overhead wires above the tracks.
Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 December	6am to 6pm  6am to 6pm	Platforms 4, 5, 6 and 7	Saw cutting and excavation to identify services within the platforms.  Backfill and compact the excavated areas.  Adjust overhead wires above the tracks.

Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 December <b>(details to be confirmed, more information will be available on the project webpage closer to the date)</b>	6am to 6pm  6am to 6pm	Platform 10 and Sydney Trains car park adjacent to the Marian Street station entrance	Service route investigations with the platform.  Backfill and compact excavated areas.  Tree branch trimming and vegetation removal (subject to approval).  Pedestrian access to Platform 10 will not be available on Saturday or Sunday.  Traffic control and pedestrian detour signage will be in place to direct customers via Gibbons Street.
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Subject to planning approval, there will be additional work occurring during December to prepare for major construction. We will notify the community of this work closer to the date.

## What you may notice

In advance of the work listed above, plant and equipment will be delivered into the rail corridor via various rail access gates around Redfern and Eveleigh. Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor, including Gibbons Street, Carriageworks Way and Little Eveleigh Street. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.

Equipment to be used during the work includes flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, compactors, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

There are a number of other work groups working between Macdonaldtown and Eveleigh on these scheduled trackwork weekends. Residents may notice increased work vehicle movements along local streets as a result of these work activities.

For the safety of staff and customers this work needs to be completed during scheduled trackwork weekends when trains are not running. For up-to-date information about services during these times visit [transportnsw.info](http://transportnsw.info) or call **131 500**.
