## Sustainable Procurement Commitments

*The Novo Rail Program Alliance Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse Project team wish to "Build and Support a Transport System that improves our present social, environmental and economic needs while maintaining the quality of life of future generations."*

The overarching sustainable procurement principles of the Project are to:

- Undertake procurement activities that achieve the best value for money solution for Transport for NSW while reducing the overall operating cost of the asset (**Economic**)
- Deliver a project that minimises the impact on the environment through the asset life-cycle, i.e. planning, design, construction, commissioning and testing through to asset handover (**Environmental**)
- Deliver a project that benefits society, especially local, disadvantaged and underrepresented groups (**Social**).

We aim to proactively engage our supply chain as critical partners in these commitments and through our procurement and contract management processes, we expect our contractors and suppliers to:

- Commit themselves to support us in implementing these Commitments
- Comply with regulatory and Transport for NSW contractual requirements
- Have in place the capability and capacity to deliver high performance sustainability outcomes
- Help us to meet our reporting obligations.

Where appropriate, the Project will also take on a more 'hands-on' approach to train and support its contractors and suppliers in developing and fostering their sustainability capability and performance. Training will also be provided to Novo Rail staff to ensure a project-wide commitment towards sustainable procurement is realised.

Novo Rail will regularly review this Commitments Statement to ensure its suitability and relevance.
