Roseville Station Upgrade

Community Notification

January 2020

Planning is underway for an accessibility upgrade at Roseville Station. As part of the planning process, preliminary investigations are scheduled to be undertaken to identify ground conditions and existing services at the station. Findings from the investigations will aid in informing the design, and in the preparation of planning documentation for the upgrade. Planning documentation is due to be placed on public display in the coming months, and the community will be invited to review documentation and provide formal feedback.

Site Investigations

Site surveys are scheduled to commence from **2am Monday 27 January to 2am Tuesday 28 January 2020** to undertake ground condition surveys. The investigations will include visual inspections, and the creation of test pits on the island platform and on Hill Street to test ground conditions and locate buried services. Equipment to be used includes lighting towers during evening periods, rail and truck mounted drilling rigs, light vehicles and hand held tools.

Monday's investigations are planned to occur during a period of scheduled track maintenance, to improve the safety of workers and minimise impact on the community. For information about rail replacement buses during this period, please visit <https://transportnsw.info/trip#/> or phone 131 500.

Investigation will also occur during the day on Tuesday 28 January on Hill Street. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and vehicles while work is carried out. Please follow directional signage and the instructions from traffic controllers during this time. Work may be noisy at times. We will implement measures to minimise impacts on the community by switching off equipment when it is not being used, placing equipment as far away from residential properties as possible, and monitoring our work activities to ensure noise levels are being managed effectively.

Facilities being constructed include a new lift, canopy, a new bike shelter, accessible pathways, formalised and new kiss and ride zones, accessible parking and new accessible amenities such as a family accessible toilet.
