



Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link

Night work, President Avenue, Kirrawee

Due to the recent wet weather the night work dates have changed and will no longer be completed on Wednesday 22 January and Thursday 23 January. Work outside standard hours will now be completed between **6pm and 5am on Tuesday 28 January and Wednesday 29 January 2020**. This work needs to be completed during these hours to ensure the safety of workers and residents, and to reduce traffic impacts.

Activities to be completed during these hours will include asphaltting of the new pathway along President Avenue between Acacia Road and Fauna Place. The equipment required includes trucks, a concrete-saw, a generator, lighting and various hand and power tools.

This work may be noisy at times, as it includes truck movements, excavating, concreting and asphaltting. A noise assessment has been prepared in accordance with the project's planning approval, and it has been determined that most work will be at least clearly audible however the team will do everything possible to minimise impacts on the community including completing noisier works as early as possible, switching off equipment when it is not being used, placing equipment as far away from residential properties as possible, and monitoring our work activities to ensure noise levels are being managed effectively.

Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes

There are ongoing pedestrian detours in place while work is occurring between Acacia Road and Fauna Place. Please follow directional signage and assistance of traffic controllers to safe pathways. Traffic changes including lane closures and detours may be in place during work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
