St Peters Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

December 2020

Planning is underway for an accessibility upgrade at St Peters Station as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program. This will provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

As part of the planning process, preliminary investigations help identify what upgrades will be required to make St Peters Station fully accessible. This involves geotechnical work and surveying at the station.

These works will take place at the station, on Platforms 3 and 4, from **6am to 6pm on Saturday 12 December** and **Sunday 13 December**. To ensure the safety of workers and customers, this work will be undertaken during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend.

These works will include:

- drilling investigative boreholes
- · design surveys
- topographical surveys
- identifying services

Equipment used will include:

- a small boring rig
- vacuum truck
- · powered hand tools and surveying equipment
- generators
- crane truck
- pressure washer

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.

Plant and machinery will access the rail corridor via the rail access gates on Bolton Street, Sydenham.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience while we carry out these works.
