New Southern Concourse

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

September - October 2020

The Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams and customers with luggage. The New Southern Concourse will improve accessibility to public transport and help people move around the growing area and is the first step in the renewal of the Redfern North Eveleigh Precinct.

Upcoming work

Minor work continues at Redfern Station to inform the design of the station upgrade. We are also taking this opportunity to undertake service searching and investigation work, and saw cutting of the platform areas prior to weekend works. These work activities will primarily be located within the rail corridor and undertaken during standard working hours 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.

In addition to activities during standard working hours, some weekend and night work will occur in September and October during scheduled trackwork weekends:

Backfill and compact the excavated areas. Pedestrian access to Platform 10 will not be available on this weekend. Traffic control and pedestrian detour signs will be in place to direct customers via Gibbons Street.
		Rail corridor – north and south of the Redfern Station platforms	Investigate underground service locations within the rail corridor.

A reminder notification for the October weekend work activities will be issued to the community closer to the date of the work commencing.

What you may notice

In advance of the work listed above, plant and equipment will be delivered into the rail corridor via various rail access gates in Redfern and Eveleigh. Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor, including Gibbons Street, Carriageworks Way and Little Eveleigh Street. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.

Equipment to be used during the work includes flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, vacuum trucks, concrete saw, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, compactors, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools. The concrete truck and concrete pump will operate over the weekend from the Sydney Trains car park at the corner of Rosehill and Marian Streets.

For the safety of staff and customers this work needs to be completed during scheduled trackwork weekends when trains are not running. For up to date information about services during these times visit transportnsw.info or call **131 500**.
