New Southern Concourse

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

The Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse will provide a station that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents / carers with prams and customers with luggage. The New Southern Concourse will improve accessibility to public transport and help people move around the growing area and is the first step in the renewal of the Redfern North Eveleigh Precinct.

Upcoming work

From now until December 2020, minor work will occur at Redfern Station to inform the design of the station upgrade. We are also taking this opportunity to remove redundant infrastructure such as overhead wire structures and wires and install new low voltage power cables within the platforms to upgrade public address systems and platform lighting. These work activities will primarily be located within the rail corridor and undertaken during standard working hours 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.

In addition to activities during standard working hours, some weekend and night work will occur in August during a scheduled trackwork weekend:

What you may notice

In advance of the work listed above, plant and equipment will be delivered into the rail corridor via various rail access gates in Redfern, Eveleigh and Erskineville. Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor, including Burren Street and Erskineville Road.

Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.

Equipment to be used during the work includes flatbed crane trucks, drilling rigs, vacuum trucks, compactors, lighting towers and generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

Why are we doing this work now?

Completing this work allows the project team to continue progressing the design and, subject to planning approval, start construction sooner, reducing the duration of the project. For the safety of staff and customers some of this work needs to be completed during scheduled trackwork weekends when trains are not running.
