COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

JANUARY 2020

Transport for NSW is upgrading electrical infrastructure as part of the Power Supply Upgrade Program, which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains.

Upcoming activities

In January 2020 we will continue work to install power poles and new overhead wires that provide the power supply into the rail corridor. The work will occur between Bridge Road, Hornsby and the Pacific Highway, Asquith.

Friday 10 to Saturday 11 January	9pm – 8am	<ul style="list-style-type: none">– Installation of a new power pole on Jersey Street North, Hornsby (near the corner of Bridge Road).– Jersey Street North will be closed to traffic between Bridge Road, Hornsby and the Pacific Highway, Asquith during this work. Traffic will be detoured via Peats Ferry Road (see map over the page).– Vehicle access to residential properties between Mildred Avenue and Bridge Road will be restricted between 11pm and 3am during the installation of overhead wires.
Saturday 11 to Sunday 12 January	9pm – 8am	<ul style="list-style-type: none">– Installation of overhead wires on power poles between Hornsby Station and the Pacific Highway, Asquith and along Jersey Street North, Hornsby.– The two northbound lanes on Jersey Street North, (between Bridge Road, Hornsby and the Pacific Highway, Asquith) will be closed between 9pm and 8am.– Two way traffic will be maintained however some traffic delays may be experienced.– Traffic control, signage and electronic signboards will also be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.

Power to some properties will be disconnected during this work. Impacted properties will be notified separately by Ausgrid.

Sunday 12 to Monday 13 January	8pm – 5am	<ul style="list-style-type: none">– Installation of overhead wires on power poles between Hornsby Station and the Pacific Highway, Asquith and along Jersey Street North, Hornsby.– There will be a single lane closure on Jersey Street North, (between Bridge Road, Hornsby and the Pacific Highway, Asquith).– There will be a westbound single lane closure on Bridge Road, Hornsby (between Peats Ferry Road and Railway Parade).

Ausgrid work activities

Ausgrid will temporarily disconnect power to some properties during the work between:

- **9pm Friday 10 and 10am Saturday 11 January**
- **8.45pm Saturday 11 and 9am Sunday 12 January**

Construction equipment

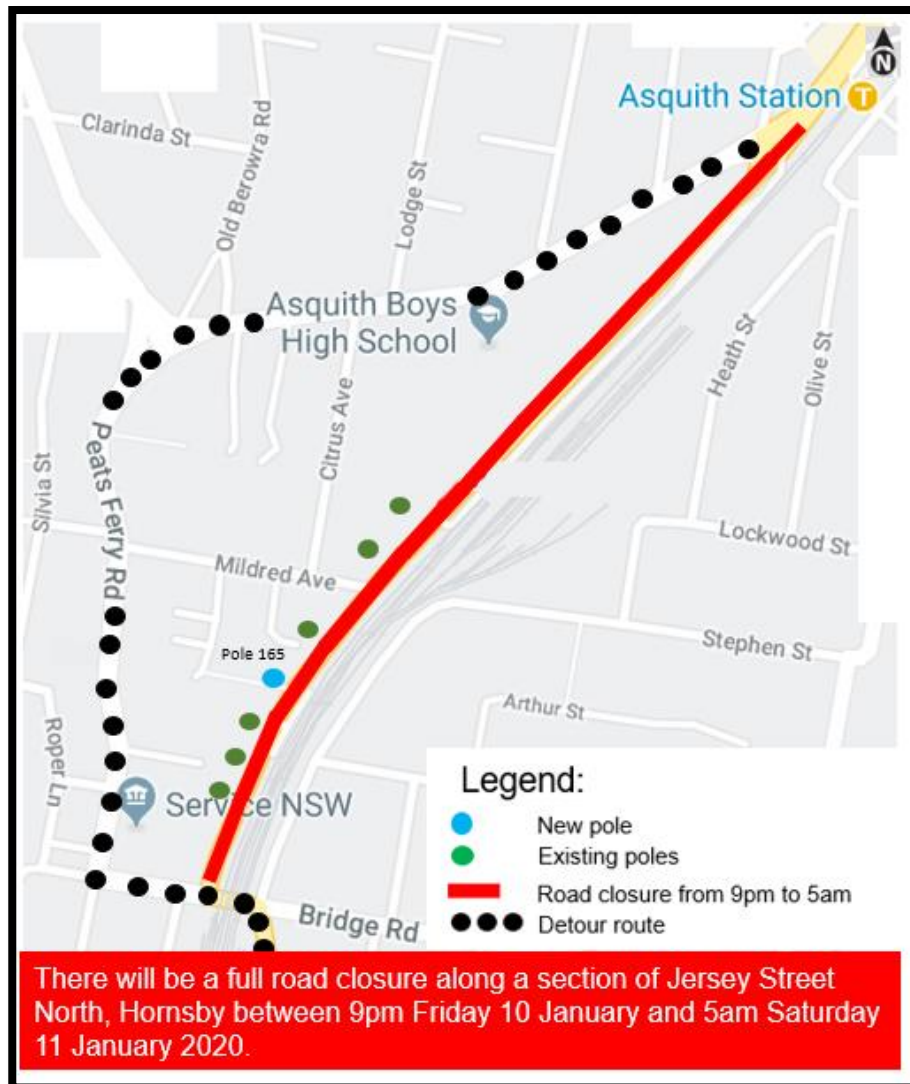
