Planning approval has been granted for the Wahroonga Station Upgrade

Planning approval follows the public display of the project's Review of Environmental Factors, which was held from 3 - 17 December 2019.

The project team received 40 submissions during the public display period.

Each submission was considered by the project team and responded to in a Determination Report.

Transport Access Program

The upgrade of Wahroonga Station is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

The Wahroonga Station Upgrade will provide accessibility to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

The upgrade will include:

- refurbishment of the Redleaf Avenue bridge and the pedestrian walkway structure with a new footbridge
- a new passenger lift and station entrance to provide access from the Redleaf Avenue bridge to the island platform
- a new walkway at platform level linking the lift to the platform
- a new accessible ramp and pathway between the station and the Wahroonga shopping village
- an interchange zone on Railway Avenue to provide an accessible parking space and spaces for taxis and kiss and ride
- an additional canopy for weather protection on the platform at the boarding assistance zone (north of the station building)
- improved amenities such as a new family accessible toilet and unisex ambulant toilet
- improved CCTV and lighting.

Feedback from the community

The key themes that emerged during the public display period included:

- support for the station becoming accessible
- desire for additional customer access to the station from the Coonanbarra Road footbridge
- desire for additional canopy cover on the platform, stairs to the concourse and the new ramp and stairs to Redleaf Avenue bridge
- clarification on the design of the new ramp and stairs between Railway Avenue and Redleaf Avenue bridge and how pedestrian movements would be managed in the precinct.

Next Steps

Design and site preparation work will occur over the coming months, with major construction expected to start in late 2020.

We will advise the local community of construction activities prior to work starting.
