Waratah Station Upgrade

Night work update

4 June 2020

On Wednesday 11 and Sunday 21 June work will be done from 7pm to 5am (weather permitting).

This work was previously scheduled to take place across two nights between Sunday 28 June and Sunday 5 July 2020.

The work on Sunday 21 June will be done during a planned Ausgrid power interruption. Residents and businesses affected by the interruption will receive more information from Ausgrid about the timing of each power interruption.

Scope of work

While the date has changed, the scope of the work will remain the same.

Our night work includes the following activities:

- 11 June: install power poles near Waratah Park /Platt Street station entry
- 21 June: temporary cut-off of local power supply to ensure worker safety
connecton of new power supply to the station
restoration of local power supply to nearby homes and businesses.

Equipment to be used includes a specialised plant for pole installation, delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, power and hand tools.

Traffic impacts

There will be a temporary lane closure on Platt Street during our night work. Please allow extra travel time. Traffic control and signs will be in place to help pedestrians and motorists with the changes.

Construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work.

Thank you for your patience while we carry out this work.
