

# **Transport Access Program**

Wollstonecraft Station Upgrade

#### **Project update**

December 2020 and January 2021

Transport for NSW is upgrading Wollstonecraft Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

## **Upcoming work**

Work will continue in December and January and includes:

- Construction of the lift bases and walls on Platforms 1 and 2, including installation of formwork, reinforcement and concrete
- Construction of bridge footings on Platform 2
- Commencement of building work on both platforms including electrical upgrade work
- Toilet refurbishment (one unisex toilet will remain open)
- Spoil and material removal and deliveries

- Temporary removal of Cabbage Leaf Palms to enable construction of an electrical cabinet. The trees will be stored off site will be replanted in the same area when construction is complete
- Piling work on eastern walkway entry to Platform1
- Excavation of trenches for electrical routes along walkways and platform
- Drainage installation on both platforms.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, trucks, grinders, saws, cranes, rattle guns, piling rigs, plumbing tools, scaffolding, propping, demolition tools, pallet jacks, trucks and hand tools. Traffic control will be in place intermittently to ensure safe pedestrian and vehicle movements around the work site. Some on-street parking may be used intermittently where required to carry out the work.

The work will be noisy at times. Wherever possible measures to reduce noise will be implemented including scheduling noisy work during daytime hours, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers.

#### Night work 2-4 December

The removal and delivery of equipment from Platform 2 to Shirley Road will take place for **1 night** only between **Wednesday 2 December** and **Friday 4 December 2020**.

This work should take about 1 hour and will be completed between 1.30am and 4am.

Equipment will include an elevated work platform and excavator and truck deliveries

#### Temporary changes to the station toilets

Work will begin to refurbish the existing toilets to provide one family accessible toilet and two ambulant toilets.

To enable this upgrade, one toilet will be closed at a time while work is carried out. During this time one toilet will be converted to a unisex toilet for all customers to use. Signage is in place to direct customers to the unisex toilet.

We apologise for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience while we carryout this important work.

#### Temporary pedestrian access, parking and road changes

From **7am Monday 23 November** to **5pm Friday 18 December 2020**, and from **7am Monday 4 January** to **5pm Friday 22 January 2021**, the entrance to Platform 1 from Shirley Road will be temporarily closed to enable construction. This is to allow piling work to be carried out and an electrical transformer to be installed. Customers will detour via the Platform 2 entry through the underpass or via Shirley Lane to access Platform 1.

During these closure periods, the northern footpath on Shirley Road bridge and the eastbound lane on Shirley Road bridge between Telopea Street and Milner Crescent will be closed intermittently. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists while the changes are in place.

Five parking spaces will be temporarily closed on Shirley Road between Wollstonecraft Station and Milner Crescent. Vehicle and pedestrian access to 50 Shirley Road will be maintained at all times.


