Wollstonecraft Station Upgrade

Project update

November 2020

Transport for NSW is upgrading Wollstonecraft Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in November and includes:

- Construction of the lift bases and walls on Platforms 1 and 2, including installation of formwork
- Construction of bridge footings on Platform 2
- Commencement of building work on both platforms including electrical upgrade work
- Toilet refurbishment (one unisex toilet will remain open)
- Spoil and material removal and deliveries
- Temporary removal of Cabbage Leaf Palm to enable construction on of an electrical cabinet. The Palm will be replanted in the same area once the construction is complete
- Piling work on Platform1

Equipment to be used includes grinders, saws, cranes (from Shirley Road), rattle guns, piling rig, plumbing tools, scaffolding, propping, demolition tools, pallet jacks, trucks and hand tools. Traffic control will be in place intermittently to ensure safe pedestrian and vehicle movements around the work site. Some on-street parking may be used intermittently where required to carry out the work.

The work will be noisy at times. Wherever possible measures to reduce noise will be implemented including scheduling noisy work during daytime hours, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers.

Temporary impacts to the station toilets

During November, work will begin to refurbish the existing toilets at Wollstonecraft Station.

To enable this upgrade, one toilet at a time will be closed to customers while the work is carried out. Signage will be in place to notify customers which toilet is operational and which is temporarily closed. One unisex toilet will remain open for customer use at all times.

Temporary pedestrian access, parking and road changes

From **Monday 23 to Friday 27 November 2020**, between **7am** and **5pm**, there will be a temporary lane closure on Shirley Road Bridge from Telopea Street to Milner Crescent. This is to allow piling work to be carried out.

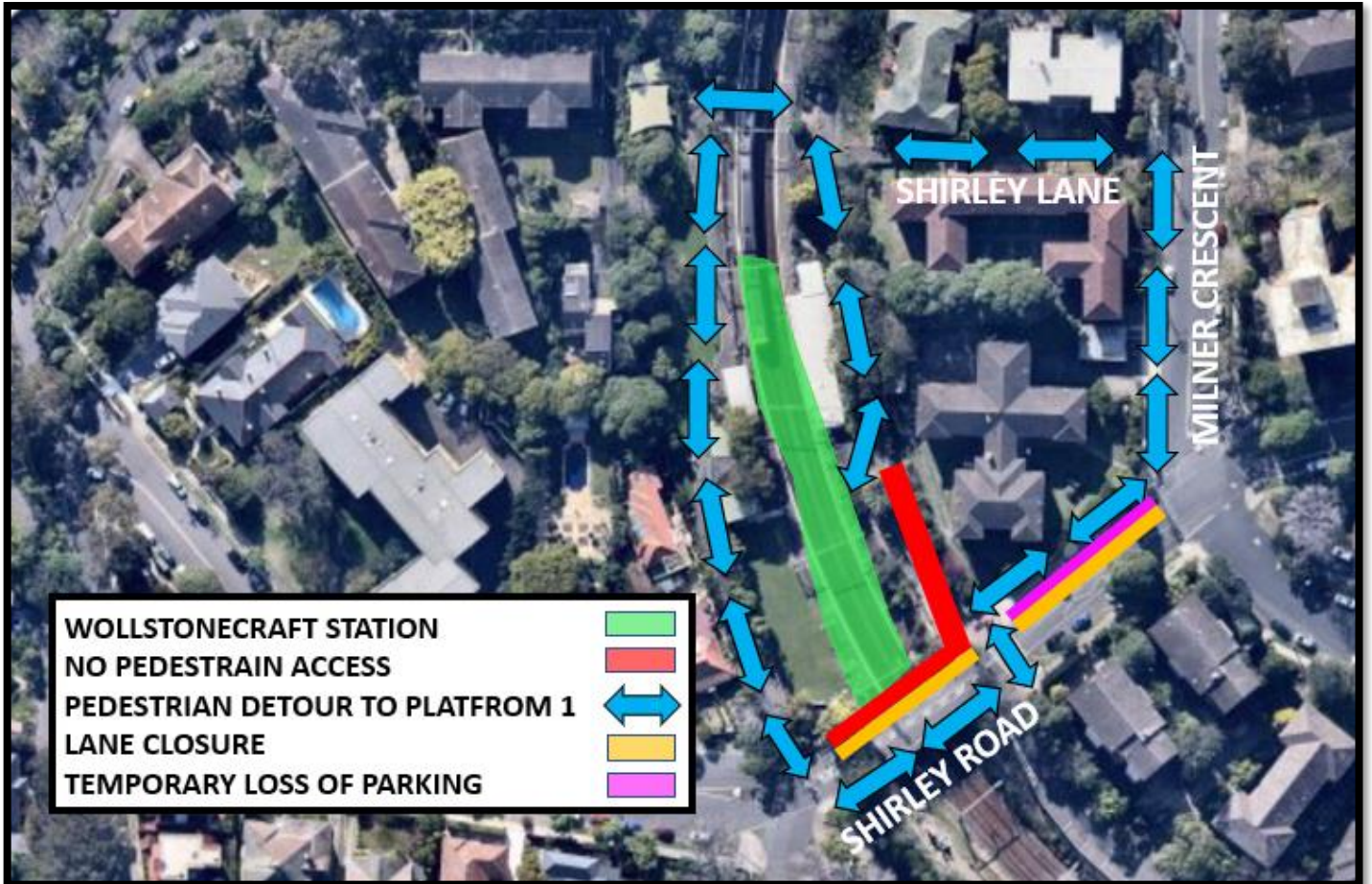
There will also be a temporary loss of five parking spaces on Shirley Road between Wollstonecraft Station and Milner Crescent. Vehicle and pedestrian access to 50 Shirley Road will be maintained at all times.

Throughout this work, the northern footpath on Shirley Road Bridge and the station entry to Platform 1 will be temporarily closed. Customers will need to detour via the Platform 2 entry through the underpass or via Shirley Lane to access Platform 1.

Traffic control and signage will be on site to assist pedestrians and motorists while these changes are in place.
