## Wye Station Upgrade

Project Update

February 2020



### February work

Construction on the Wye Station Upgrade is progressing well, with ongoing upgrades to the station facilities and construction of the lift shaft continuing throughout the month of January.

Construction activities will continue in February and will include:

- installation of the lift shaft on the Gorokan Road side of the station
- building new station access stairs and retaining walls on Wye Road
- work to the station toilets with new floor and wall tiling, internal fit out and doors for complaint access
- work to the waiting room with a new floor slab, floor tiling and seating for compliant access.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, elevated work platforms, large mobile crane, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, power and hand tools.

### Weekend work – Saturday 1 February

On **Saturday 1 February 2020 from 8am to 5pm** electrical upgrade work will be carried out by Ausgrid at the station during a planned power interruption, weather permitting.

Residents and businesses affected by the temporary interruption will receive more information from Ausgrid. The planned power interruption will commence on **Saturday 1 February 2020 at 8:30am until 5:00pm**. The station will remain open and train services will continue as normal during the work.

Equipment to be used includes elevated work platforms, trucks, power and hand tools.

### **Weekend work – Saturday 8 February**

On **Saturday 8 February 2020 from 8am to 10pm** weekend work will be carried out at the station, weather permitting.

Activities include using a large crane to install the lift shaft on the Gorokan Road side of the station.

Equipment to be used includes mobile cranes, delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, power and hand tools.

The construction plant will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods for any noisy work.

### **Pedestrian detours**

To safely operate the large crane on Saturday 8 February, temporary pedestrian access changes will be in place during the work. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with these temporary changes. See the map overleaf for more information.

### Ongoing access changes to Gorokan Road Commuter Car Park

Access to the Gorokan Road Commuter Car Park has changed to enable construction of the new station entry to occur. Traffic control and signage is in place to assist pedestrians and vehicles with this change. Please follow directional signage and the instructions from traffic controllers during standard working hours. This change is temporary and will be in place until mid-2020.

### Toilet and waiting room closure

The existing toilets and waiting room on Platform 2 remain closed for refurbishment and are expected to re-open in April 2020. Two temporary unisex toilets are located on Platform 2 at the rear of the existing building.

### Standard construction hours

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
