Wye Station Upgrade

Project Update

April 2020

Construction on the Wye Station Upgrade is progressing well, with upgrades to the station facilities and construction of the lift shaft continuing throughout March. The station waiting room also reopened for customer use in March.

April work

Construction activities in April include:

- building new station access stairs and retaining walls on Wye Road
- internal fit out of the new accessible station toilets
- construction of a new footpath on Wye Road
- installation of new services including communications, water and power.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete trucks, concrete pumps, power and hand tools.

Temporary changes to Wye Road 'Kiss and Ride' zone

The 'Kiss and Ride' zone on Wye Road will temporarily close until June 2020 while footpath upgrades are carried out (in sections) at the station entry.

Please use Darlingup Road Commuter Car Park for pick-ups and drop-offs during this time. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists with these changes. See map overleaf.

Standard construction hours

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

The toilets on Platform 2 remain closed for refurbishment but are expected to re-open in May 2020. Two temporary unisex toilets are located on Platform 2 at the rear of the existing building.
