What we're doing

Sydney Trains is replacing the overhead wiring structures in the rail corridor between Central Station and Redfern Station. These works will take place around the clock on the weekend of 8 - 9 February.

To improve service reliability, we are carrying out:

- Vacuum excavation
- Footing construction
- Spoil disposal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place around the clock from 2am Saturday 8 February to 2am Monday 10 February.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty on Regen Street, Cleveland Street and Eveleigh Street to assist
 movements into and out of the rail corridor.
