Central to Strathfield track maintenance

From Saturday 11 July to Monday 13 July

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Central and Strathfield from Saturday 11 July to Monday 13 July.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro is:

- delivering a new transformer near the Lee Street substation
- working on platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse
- installing services throughout the station
- excavating and constructing a concrete slab for the metro platforms (underground former platforms 13, 14-15).

Sydney Trains is working on:

- bridge painting at Petersham footbridge
- contact wire renewal between Eveleigh and Macdonaldtown
- plain track and turnout resurfacing
- priority defect removals at various locations
- rail and turnout grinding
- rerailling works at Petersham and Croydon
- routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- station upgrade stage works at Redfern and Petersham
- track reconditioning at Stanmore
- vegetation maintenance, litter, and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 2am Saturday 11 July until 2am Monday 13 July.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
