How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend. We apologise for the inconvenience this may cause.
- Work will take place nightly between 10pm and 6am from Monday 14 September to Friday 18 September.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside of this time. Due to travel restrictions on large vehicles, some of these deliveries may need to take place at night.
- Equipment to be used during this work includes drill rigs, core drills, compressors, hi-rail trucks, a loader and an excavator.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
