# Auburn to Blacktown track maintenance

## From Friday 18 September to Monday 21 September

## What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Auburn and Blacktown from Friday 18 September to Monday 21 September.

At Westmead station and at Clyde, Sydney Metro will be undertaking early investigations, other inspections and activities within the rail corridor, to prepare for the construction of Sydney Metro West.

Sydney Trains is working on:

- plain track and turnout resurfacing
- rail and turnout grinding
- routine civil, signal, and electrical maintenance
- turnout refurbishment at Clyde
- litter and graffiti removal
- vegetation maintenance.

## How this affects you

#### **Noise**

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place around the clock from 11.30pm Friday 18 September until 2.30am Monday 21 September.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

#### **Traffic and Parking**

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
