Cooks River Bridge Refurbishment

From Monday 7 December 2020 to Friday 24 September 2021

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking refurbishment work on the Cooks River Rail Bridge at Tempe from Monday 7 December 2020 to Friday 24 September 2021.

The work involves abrasive sand blasting, repainting bridge steelwork and strengthening works. Shrink wrap encapsulation will be used to minimise dust and protect the environment.

To ensure safety, **the pedestrian path and cycleway which passes under the Cooks River Rail Bridge will be closed from 25 to 28 June 2021.** Refer to map on page 2.

In addition to weekday work, we will be working around the clock over three weekends in December 2020, June 2021 and September 2021.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Changes to Pedestrian path and Cycleway access

- To ensure public safety during these works, the path and cycleway approaching and beneath Cooks River Bridge will be closed during weekend works. The first cycleway closure is scheduled for **25 to 28 June 2021.**
- These works will create additional noise during the day, at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place on the following days;
 - **Around the clock from 6am Saturday 12 December to 11pm Sunday 13 December, 6am Saturday 20 February to Sunday 11pm 21 February and 6am Saturday 26 June to 11pm Sunday 27 June.**
 - **Work will take place between 7am and 5pm Monday to Fridays and between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays from Monday 7 December 2020 to Friday 24 September 2021.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles. Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
