What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance at Strathfield Station from Friday 28 March to Friday 3 April.

To improve platform accessibility, we're installing tactile indicators on Platform 8.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place during the following times:**
 - **Between 6am and 8pm on Saturday 28 March**
 - **Between 6am and 12pm on Sunday 29 March**
 - **Nightly between 8pm and 5am from Monday 30 March to Friday 3 April.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Due to travel restrictions on large vehicles, some of these deliveries may need to take place at night.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using Albert Road to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to direct pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
