# What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking staged platform construction work at Redfern Station from Monday 23 March to Friday 10 April.

To improve network safety and reduce the need for ongoing maintenance, we're reconstructing Platform 6 and Platform 7 over the coming months.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

# How this affects you

#### **Noise**

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend. We apologise for the inconvenience this may cause.
- Work will take place during the following times:
  - Monday 23 March to Friday 27 March 6am to 6pm, involving site establishment and delivery of materials.
  - Saturday 28 March 3am to Monday 30 March 6am around the clock involving platform reconstruction works.
  - Monday 30 March to Friday 10 April 6am to 6pm, involving removal of equipment.
- Work may also take place nightly between 6pm and 6am from Monday 30 March to Friday 10 April, involving concreting, surveying, painting and installation of platform tactiles.
- Equipment may be delivered and picked up from the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.

### **Traffic and Parking**

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets adjacent to Redfern Station (Little Eveleigh Street, Lawson Street and Cornwallis Street) and Erskineville Station (Swanson Street) to access the rail corridor.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist vehicle movements in and out of the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.


