What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance at Mount Druitt Station from Saturday 18 April to Sunday 19 April.

We will be resurfacing the carpark on North Parade. Disabled spaces will be temporary relocated to the eastern side of the North Parade carpark.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place between 7am and 5pm on Saturday 18 April.**
- Equipment will be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- **The commuter car park on North Parade will be closed from 6pm Friday 17 April to 12pm Sunday 19 April. Temporary disabled spaces will be relocated to the eastern North Parade carpark.**
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the duration of the works to assist motorists on North Parade.
