

City Circle to Lidcombe track maintenance

From Saturday 28 March to Monday 30 March

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance around the City Circle and Lidcombe from Saturday 28 March to Monday 30 March.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro are doing track work on tracks 19 and 20 ahead of future work for Central Walk, working on platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse and excavating for the metro platforms (underground former platforms 13, 14-15).

Sydney Trains is working on:

- plain track and turnout resurfacing
- platform reconstruction works at Redfern
- rail and turnout grinding
- rerailing works between Croydon and Ashfield
- routine civil, signal and electrical maintenance
- turnout removal works at Strathfield and Homebush
- litter and graffiti removal
- vegetation maintenance.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 2am Saturday 28 March until 2am Monday 30 March.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
