City Circle to Turrella track maintenance

From Tuesday 3 August to Friday 27 August

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance around the City Circle and Turrella from Tuesday 3 August to Friday 27 August.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro is:

- Working within the hoardings on Platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse
- Installing services throughout the station
- Constructing concrete slabs for the metro platforms (underground former Platforms 13, 14-15).

Sydney Trains is working on:

- Civil track maintenance
- Track defect removal works
- Routine signal and electrical maintenance
- Station maintenance works, to improve safety on stations.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise on weeknights.
- **Work will take place nightly during the following period:**
 - Tuesday 3 August to Friday 6 August between 1am and 4am
 - Tuesday 10 August to Friday 13 August between 1am and 4am
 - Tuesday 17 August to Friday 20 August between 1am and 4am
 - Tuesday 24 August to Friday 27 August between 1am and 4am.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
