Central to Cabramatta track maintenance

From Friday 15 October to Monday 18 October

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Central and Cabramatta via Bankstown from Friday 15 October to Monday 18 October.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro is working within the hoardings on Platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse, installing services throughout the station, constructing concrete slabs for the metro platforms, and preparing and construction works for reinstatement of Platforms 12, 13 and 14.

Between Sydenham and Bankstown, Sydney Metro is undertaking station building, concourse and platform works, construction of services buildings, excavation and piling works, bridge works along the corridor, installation of new stairs at Canterbury, Punchbowl and Hurlstone Park, installation for steel structures for future lifts at Dulwich Hill and Punchbowl, Campsie substation work, fencing, cable service route and galvanised steel troughing along the corridor, service and utilities work, installation of anti-throw screens and devegetation when required.

Sydney Trains is working on:

- Bridge refurbishment works at Liverpool Road Overbridge, Yagoona
- Civil track maintenance
- Cutting and embankment works at Birrong
- Plain track and turnout resurfacing
- Platform reconstruction at Villawood
- Rail and turnout grinding
- · Routine signal and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Redfern, Erskineville, St Peters and Yagoona
- Track defect works at various locations
- Turnout renewal at Sydenham and Sefton
- Turnout resurfacing at Sydenham
- · Vegetation maintenance, litter and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- Work will take place around the clock from 11pm Friday 15 October until 2am Monday 18 October.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to
 day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
