


## Sutherland to Cronulla Active Transport Link (SCATL) Investigation work from Tuesday 6 October to Monday 13 December

Transport for NSW will be carrying out geotechnical and utilities investigations as part of the SCATL project in preparation for the next stage of the link.

SCATL would deliver new infrastructure to improve local transport links between local businesses, precincts and services. Further detail on the project will be released as part of the public exhibition of the Review of Environmental Factors (REF) in October 2021.

Early investigation work will include:

- Electronically locating and surveying utilities and borehole locations
- Drilling into the ground for soil sampling
- Non-destructive drilling to investigate utility locations
- Reinstating the disturbed areas



## Our work schedule

We will be on site for up to **15 day shifts** and **5 night shifts** between **Tuesday 6 October 2021 and Monday 13 December 2021**, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am to 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 5pm on Saturday**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm to 5am** from **Sunday to Friday**.

We will not work for more than two night shifts in one location.
