

Road works to start in the Badgerys Creek Road area from Monday 8 November, 2021

Transport for NSW is carrying out road enabling works to support the delivery of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport. The new metro rail will become the transport spine for Greater Western Sydney, connecting communities and travellers with the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport and the growing region. The city-shaping project will deliver new stations at the Western Sydney Aerotropolis, Western Sydney International, Luddenham, Orchard Hills and St Marys. The 23 kilometre new railway is planned to open at the same time as passenger services start at the airport.

There are four projects underway at Badgerys Creek and Bringelly that will provide road access to future Sydney Metro construction sites and a services facility, and improve traffic flow and safety for construction vehicles and general traffic **(see map below)**.



Project overview and what happens next

1 Elizabeth Drive and Badgerys Creek Road roundabout extension

The existing roundabout intersection will be changed with the addition of a fourth (4th) leg for an access road so that work vehicles can enter the Sydney Metro construction site. The project is due for completion in mid 2022 and will deliver:

- a new access road to the north of the roundabout
- new kerbing and guttering
- adjustment of utilities and installation of new drainage

Work will start in January 2022 and includes:

- establishing site fencing and traffic barriers
- set-up of erosion and sediment controls and carrying out surveys and site investigations
- grubbing and clearing of vegetation, excavation and earthworks
- stormwater adjustments and installing new drainage
- construction of the road off the roundabout
- installing signage, line marking, fencing and a gate

Equipment used will include: road-saws, jackhammers, trucks, rollers, tippers, earthmoving vehicles, light construction vehicles, light towers, cranes, milling and paving machines, excavators and generators.

2 Longleys Road and Pitt Street new link road

Longleys Road and Pitt Street will be upgraded, and a new link road to connect both roads will be built for work vehicles to access the Sydney Metro construction site. The project is due for completion in mid 2022 and will deliver:

- upgrades to the intersection of Badgerys Creek Road and Longleys Road
- widening and upgrading of Longleys Road and Pitt Street and a new link road
- upgrades to Pitt Street to cater for heavy construction vehicles
- new street lighting, signage and line markings
- adjustment of utilities and installation of new drainage

Work will start on Monday 15 November 2021 and includes:

- establishing a site compound with fencing and a site office
- set-up of erosion and sediment controls and carrying out surveys and site investigations
- grubbing and clearing of vegetation, excavation and earthworks
- utility adjustments
- road construction
- installing signage and line marking

Equipment used will include: road-saws, jackhammers, trucks, rollers, tippers, graders and earth moving vehicles, light construction vehicles, light towers, cranes, milling and paving machines, excavators and generators

3 Badgerys Creek Road new roundabout and access road

A new three (3) leg roundabout and access road will be built at 215 Badgerys Creek Road to allow work vehicles to safely enter and exit the aerotropolis construction site. The project is due for completion in mid 2022 and will deliver:

- a new, two-tier concrete roundabout with a central concrete island
- an east leg access road
- new street lighting, signage, and line marking
- new kerbing, guttering and pavement widening
- adjustment of utilities and installation of new stormwater drainage

Work will start on Monday 8 November 2021 and includes:

- grubbing and clearing of existing vegetation, and topsoil removal
- adjustments to road batter (area connecting roadside with surrounding land)
- new kerb, gutter and roundabout construction
- installing new stormwater drainage and adjusting utilities
- installing new street lighting, signage and line marking
- re-instatement of a driveway

Equipment used will include: road-saws, jackhammers, trucks, tippers, earthmoving vehicles, rollers, graders and earth moving vehicles, light construction vehicles, light towers, cranes, milling and paving machines, excavators and generators.

4 New driveway for the Bringelly Storage Facility

A driveway to access the Sydney Metro Bringelly Storage Facility will be built at 40 Derwent Road. The project is due for completion in early 2022 and will deliver:

- a new driveway to access the Storage Facility
- re-instatement of a drive-way from the road to property boundary
- relocation of utilities and stormwater drainage improvements

Work will start on Monday 29 November 2021 and includes:

- pavement construction
- drainage works under driveway entrances
- concreting and resurfacing of driveways from the road to the property boundaries
- utility adjustment and drainage works

Equipment used will include: road-saws, jackhammers, trucks, tippers, earthmoving vehicles, light construction vehicles, light towers, cranes, milling and paving machines, excavators, bob-cats and generators.

What to expect

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work to ensure that work zones are safe. This may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits, and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

- Work will generate some noise and dust, and our team will minimise impacts where possible.
- There will be an increase of light and construction vehicles near the work sites.
- Minor traffic disruptions will occur with traffic control measures in place.
- Access to driveways and properties will be maintained however, there may be some minor interruptions due to work. We will liaise with affected property owners and work to minimise impacts prior to any property access changes.

Our work schedule

Our standard work hours will be **Monday to Sunday from 7am to 6pm**. On weekends, high noise activities will only occur on Saturdays between 8am and 1pm.

Our night work hours will be **Sunday to Thursday nights from 8pm to 5am**.

Nightworks are scheduled from **Monday 8 November to Thursday 11 November** to establish traffic controls and barriers along Badgerys Creek Road, near Pitt Street, Longleys Road and 215 Badgerys Creek Road. Nightworks to deliver construction materials to the site at 215 Badgerys Creek Road are scheduled from **Sunday 14 November to Thursday 25 November**. Works will not take place on Friday and Saturday nights.

These works will be undertaken in accordance with Public Health Orders and a COVIDSafe plan is in place. Please note the evolving situation with COVID and the weather may impact our planned dates of work and require some scheduling flexibility or additional days' work.
