

# Start of construction at Schofields commuter car park from 18 October


#### October 2021

Transport for NSW is delivering approximately 700 additional commuter parking spaces at Schofields to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The car park is expected to be open to commuters in mid-2022.

Over the past few months, site investigations and detailed design have progressed. From Monday 18 October to Friday 26 November, we will begin setting up fencing and a worksite which will include facilities for construction workers. Our work will include:

- delivering plant and equipment to the site
- installing site fencing and amenities, service connections, security and site accesses
- establishing environmental control and access for construction vehicles
- · removing approved vegetation and trees on the site and on Bridge Street
- · demolishing existing hard landscaping
- · earthworks to level the site
- · removing waste materials from the site

These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-Safe plan is in place, including the use of face masks and QR codes.



#### Our work schedule

Will be on site from Monday 18 October to Friday 26 November. Our work hours will be between **7am to 6pm** on **Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturday**, weather permitting. If any additional work is required outside of these hours, the community will be notified in advance.

## How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, using noise blankets, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
