Como Station Upgrade

Project update October 2021

Transport for NSW is upgrading Como Station to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

The Como Station Upgrade is nearing completion with finalisation work continuing throughout October.



Lift and stairs from Como Parade into the station is almost complete.

Upcoming work in October includes:

Most of the work taking place in October will be occurring around the Como Parade area, including:

- finalising the retaining wall and sandstone on Como Parade
- · reinstatement of carpark with relocation of accessible parking closer to the new lift
- installation of fencing and carpark fixings
- removal of the Como Parade station access ramp
- finishing works in the underpass and on all platform areas
- commissioning of new lifts

Equipment to be used includes excavators, motorised scissor lifts and wheelbarrows, 130t crane, power tools and standard construction vehicles.

Temporary changes to access for pedestrians

The area surrounding the Como Parade station entrance will allow for the construction activities remaining to be completed concurrently. Access via Como Parade for entry and exit to the station closed on Monday 27 September and will remain closed until early November for the safety of customers and workers. Customers will need to continue to access the station via the Railway Road bridge detour.

Parking

The 30 car parking spaces closed in September will remain closed during October, with reopening now scheduled for November. These temporary closures are essential to enable safe excavation, concrete pours, deliveries and landscaping. Parking will be reinstated gradually as work progresses. Traffic control measures will be in place for the safety of motorists and pedestrians, as required.

Construction Hours

To support the industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites to operate on weekends and public holidays. Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm every day, including Sundays and public holidays**. These changes have been made to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.

Out of hours work

There will be some scheduled night work happening between **Wednesday 27 October and Friday 29 October 2021**, none of this work will be audible.

How are we staying safe

The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-19 Safe plan is in place, including masks and QR codes.
