

Redfern Station Upgrade

New Southern Concourse

Project update

Throughout November, construction will continue on the upgrade of Redfern Station, activities will include:

- final preparation work for the commencement of construction on the new shared zone and station entrance on Little Eveleigh Street, this work will include the North Eveleigh car park
- work at the Marian Street and North Eveleigh compound area and on the bridge, including construction of the bridge canopy, lift shafts and stairs
- potholing and installation of a new service route and storage of materials in the rail corridor adjacent to Regent Street

Throughout the scheduled work activities, measures are in place to mitigate any noise or vibration impacts. This includes a real-time environmental management system to monitor that noise, vibration, and dust levels are operating within our project requirements. Any impacts to the community will be managed in line with our Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan available on our project webpage transport.nsw.gov.au/redfern under the “Management Plans” section.

All activities being undertaken adhere to COVID safe practices and will continue to be in line with NSW Health’s COVID-19 Public Health Orders and restrictions.

Little Eveleigh Street update

Although construction of the Little Eveleigh Street Shared Zone has been delayed due to a pause in the construction of the Little Eveleigh Street interim car park, final preparation work for the new shared zone will continue throughout November on Little Eveleigh Street, and between Wilson Street and Ivy Lane. Activities will include the temporary removal of bollards, adjustments and asphaltting on the curbing, removal of a garden bed and trimming of trees.

Construction of the car park will continue throughout November. This includes vegetation clearance and tree trimming to enable access into the car park, and construction of the car park accessway, retaining walls, footpaths, curbs and guttering, and installation of paving, fencing and gates.

Activities such as minor internal material removal and structural work will continue inside 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street building, as well as deliveries of equipment and materials within the hoarded area. As previously notified, two trees outside of the building will be removed to facilitate construction of the new Redfern Station entrance.

Work will also be undertaken with Ausgrid to modify overhead powerlines on Little Eveleigh Street, resulting in a temporary loss of power to some properties. Ausgrid will directly notify any impacted properties with further information closer to the date.

Station area and platforms update

Final work to move the heritage building and other activities will continue on and behind Platform 1. These activities include rock breaking, piling, concreting, drilling and material removal. A vacuum truck will be used to finalise the moving of the heritage building, and a crane will be periodically used to lift various materials into place.

Work continues inside the platform hoardings on support structures and on the bridge deck for construction of the lift shafts, stairs and bridge canopy. Installation of cable casing will also continue along the canopy, across the platforms and on the existing Northern Concourse during November.

Marian Street update

An arborist will be undertaking required tree trimming along Rosehill and Marian Streets to form a safe pathway for plant and equipment. Traffic control will be present to temporarily stop traffic when tree branches are being trimmed to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Work on the assembly of lift shafts, other bridge components and the electrical building will continue in the Marian Street Compound. This compound will also be periodically used by a crane to lift various materials into place.

Upcoming deliveries and parking removal

Up to 5 parking spaces on Rosehill Street and 3 on Marian Street will be temporarily removed from **28 to 29 October**.

Up to 20 parking spaces on Rosehill Street and 6 on Marian Street will be temporarily removed from **17 to 22 November**. Up to 6 parking spaces will also be unavailable from **24 to 26 November** on Marian Street. These dates are subject to change, but traffic control and signage will be in place.

There will be an increase in large truck deliveries into the North Eveleigh and Marian Street compounds that may need to occur between **10pm and 5am** Monday to Sunday, depending on their size. These deliveries are not expected to be noisy.

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturday.

What you may notice

Equipment to be used during these activities may include cranes, elevated work platforms, access equipment, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, core hole drills, compactors, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

Sometimes, our activities require the use of equipment that operates at a higher sound level than standard equipment. This includes power saws, grinders, jackhammers, rollers, rattle guns, vacuum trucks, rock hammers or breakers and piling rigs.

This work will be noisy at times. We will minimise noise impacts by turning off equipment when not in use and using noise absorbing blankets where possible.

Please note the use of rollers, generators, piling rigs and excavators across the Marian Street Compound, on and behind Platform 1 and on the North Eveleigh car park can cause vibration and may be noticeable to nearby residents. Real-time vibration levels are monitored across different areas of the project to ensure the project is operating within its requirements.
