

# Redfern Station Upgrade

## New Southern Concourse

### Project update

Throughout October, construction activities will continue for the upgrade of Redfern Station, these will consist of:

- preparation work and relocation of the heritage building on and behind Platform 1
- preparation work for the shared zone and new station entrance on Little Eveleigh Street, including work on the North Eveleigh car park
- work at the Marian Street compound area and on the bridge, including construction of the bridge canopy, lift shafts and stairs that will form part of the New Southern Concourse.

At times, these activities may generate noise and vibration. We have a real-time environmental management system that monitors for noise, vibration and dust levels to ensure that we are operating within the project guidelines, and any impacts will be managed in line with our Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan which is available on our project webpage [transport.nsw.gov.au/redfern](https://transport.nsw.gov.au/redfern) under the “Management Plans” section.

During this work we will be continuing to implement COVID safe practices in line with NSW Health’s COVID-19 Public Health Orders and restrictions.

## Little Eveleigh Street update

Preparation work for the new shared zone will continue in October. Activities in the thoroughfare between Wilson Street and Ivy Lane include the temporary removal of bollards, adjustments and asphaltting on the curbing, removal of a garden bed and trimming of trees.

Construction activities on the car park will also continue, including vegetation clearance and tree trimming to enable access into the car park.

Activities such as soft stripping, minor internal removal and structural work will continue inside the 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street building, as well as deliveries of equipment and materials within the hoarded area. As previously notified, two trees outside of the building will be removed to facilitate construction of the new Redfern Station entrance.

Additional exploration of underground services and potholing may be required on Little Eveleigh Street and Ivy Street from **Friday 1 October to Sunday 31 October**. Up to six car spaces will be periodically unavailable during this time. These activities may not be required every day; however, they are dependant on weather conditions and availability of parking. Signage and traffic control will be in place to safely direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians during this work.

Work is being undertaken with Ausgrid to modify overhead powerlines on Little Eveleigh Street. This may require some temporary loss of power to some properties. Ausgrid will directly notify any impacted properties with further information once details are confirmed for October or November.

## Platforms and Marian Street update

Final preparation work will take place behind and on Platform 1 before the heritage building is relocated in October. A vacuum truck will be used throughout the month to finalise the movement of the building.

Rock breaking, piling, concreting, drilling and material removal will continue on and behind Platform 1. Equipment will also be installed to assist with the efficient removal of material from this area.

Work continues inside the platform hoardings on support structures and on the bridge deck for construction of the lift shafts, stairs and bridge canopy.

Cable casing will be installed along the canopy, across the platforms, and on the existing Northern Concourse during October.

An arborist will undertake required tree trimming along Rosehill and Marian Streets to ensure a safe pathway for plant and equipment. Traffic control will be present to temporarily stop traffic when the tree branches are being trimmed. Minor traffic delays may be experienced to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Foundation work, installation of underground service routes and work on the assembly of lift shafts will also continue in the Marian Street Compound.

**Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturday.**

## What you may notice

Equipment to be used during these activities may include cranes, elevated work platforms, access equipment, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, core hole drills, compactors, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

Sometimes, our activities require the use of equipment that operates at a higher sound level than standard equipment. This includes power saws, grinders, jackhammers, rollers, rattle guns, vacuum trucks, rock hammers or breakers and piling rigs.
