

## **Transport Access Program**

Petersham Station Upgrade

## **Project completion**

September 2021

Petersham Station Upgrade is now complete and the community is able to use the station's new and improved accessibility features, including:

- two new lifts to access all platforms and amenities
- an upgraded family accessible toilet and ambulant toilet
- CCTV and lighting improvements to increase safety and security around the station precinct
- one new accessible parking space and kiss and ride area on Terminus Street.

The project was completed as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure.

## **Finishing work**

While the new lifts and key features of the Petersham Station Upgrade are now open, minor finishing works will continue to be carried out during September 2021.

## Heritage features

In addition to the accessible features, the station upgrade has delivered a heritage interpretation with the installation of new lighting along the pedestrian footbridge.

The replica heritage lights (pictured below) are inspired by lanterns at the station in the 1890s.
