Pymble Station Upgrade

The Pymble Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

We thank you for your patience during this important work.

Project update

The Pymble Station Upgrade team have successfully completed the piling work for the new lifts. You may have noticed the temporary fencing and hoarding installed on Grandview Street and the station platforms. We have also commenced the refurbishment of the station bathrooms to convert them into accessible toilets.

We understand that this year has been challenging for all, so the Pymble Station Upgrade project team would like to thank the community for their understanding and support for the project.

For the safety of pedestrians and motorists, the tree removal work will be carried out at night. Once complete, parts of the tree will be donated to wildlife parks across Sydney.

December work

Work will continue up until Tuesday 21 December at Pymble Station and will include:

- some vegetation clearing
- work on the lifts with precast concrete installation for the lifts adjacent to Grandview Street
- upgrades to the toilets located on the platform
- concreting work within the rail corridor for the new electrical Pad-mount
- ongoing work of the bus demolition located on Grandview Street.

Our work will **conclude this year on Tuesday 21 December 2021** and **resume on Monday 10 January 2022**.

Tree removal

We recently notified of you of the removal of the Wallangarra White Gum, located in the Pacific Highway car park and the Brush Box tree on Grandview Street, that was planned to occur in November 2021. This work will now be carried out in December 2021.

Nightwork

Between **7pm and 5am Monday 13 December to Thursday 16 December**, we will be carrying out the following activities:

- removal of the Wallangarra White Gum Tree located in the Pacific Highway car park and a Brush Box tree on Grandview Street
- removal of bus shelter on Grandview Street
- precast installation for the new lift under a full road Closure on Grandview Street.

Plant and equipment

Equipment used throughout December includes excavators, vacuum truck, road saw, tipper truck, flatbed truck, tilt tray, concrete truck and pumps, dump truck, elevated working platforms, crane, chipper, various hand and power tools.

Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes

The Pacific Highway car park will be closed during our night work times to allow for the tree removal to take place.

A temporary road closure will be in place on Grandview Street, between Station Street and Alma Street to allow for the precast concrete to be installed for the new lift.

This road closure will take place during our night work. A detour will be in place via Station Street, Alma Street and Park Crescent.

During the Wallangara White Gum tree removal, a temporary lane closure will be in place on the Pacific Highway southbound kerbside lane.

The bus stop on Grandview Street will be temporarily closed to allow for construction of the new bus shelter to be carried out.
