

## Investigation work at Doonside Station from 20 September

September 2021

The NSW Government is proposing to improve accessibility at Doonside Station as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out geotechnical and utilities investigations for the proposed upgrade of Doonside Station to make it easier to access, especially for people with disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID-Safe plan is in place, including the use of face masks and QR codes.

Investigation work will include potholing and scanning for services and utilities.

### Our work schedule

We will be on site from **7am to 6pm on Thursday 23 September and Friday 24 September** to prepare the site for the weekend work.

From **5am to 6pm on Saturday 25 September and Sunday 26 September** we will be completing the following activities:

- Installing an access ramp

- Potholing and services investigation
- Inspecting the station footbridge
- Scanning for services and utilities.

Potholing and service investigations will also take place the following week from **Monday 27 September to Friday 1 October between 7am and 6pm.**

## How will the work affect you?

The work may be noisy at times but we will do everything to lessen the disturbance including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, using noise blankets, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. These include:

- A pedestrian detour will be in place while potholing on public footpaths and grass strips on School Parade, Cross Street, Doonside Road, Doonside Crescent and Coghlan Crescent
- Up to three parking spaces adjacent to the station entrance on Doonside Crescent next to the pedestrian crossing and three parking spaces on Cross Street will be unavailable **from 5am to 6pm between Thursday 23, and Sunday 26 and between Monday 27 September to Friday 1 October** to allow for machinery to access the work zone safely.
- The station footbridge **will remain open** during this time.
- Signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the area when required.
