

# Commuter Car Park Program

Edmondson Park

Project update

June 2021

Transport for NSW is delivering more commuter car parking at Edmondson Park Station to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads.

The car park located south of the station will have approximately 1,000 additional commuter spaces and is expected to be open to customers in mid-2021.

## Construction progress update

In May, concrete pours for the new car park continued with several major pours, including walls and columns. Electrical and plumbing installation work is also progressing. Fit out works have also commenced with the installation of guard rails, façade brackets and internal painting.

## Upcoming construction work

During June, the following work will occur on the new multi-storey car park:

- Continuation of concrete pours
- Construction of load bearing walls and columns
- Construction of stairs and lift cores

- Plumbing and electrical work within the building
- High voltage electrical work
- Removal of formwork from lower floors

## Construction hours

Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday**. This is to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.

## Upcoming Out of Hours Works

### Temporary closure of Ed Square driveway (off MacDonald Road) – evenings of Monday 7 and Tuesday 8 June

Work is now underway along MacDonald Road to connect the new multi-storey car park to water services. Whilst majority of this work is being carried out behind construction fencing we need to cross the driveway to Ed Square off MacDonald Road to complete the connection. In order to complete this work safely, **we need to temporarily close the driveway**. To minimise impacts to the surrounding community, we will undertake this work at night from **6pm – 10pm on Monday 7 June and Tuesday 8 June**. We don't expect this work to be noisy to nearby residents and will endeavour to minimise noise as much as possible. Access to Ed Square will be maintained from Soldiers Parade and traffic control and signage will be in place to help the community with the temporary access changes.

### Concrete pours

During June, five major concrete pours are expected to occur on site for the new multi-storey car park. Whilst majority of the work will occur during standard construction hours, finishing work will need to be undertaken out of hours between 6pm-10pm on the following dates:

- Tuesday 8 June
- Thursday 10 June
- Thursday 17 June
- Friday 18 June
- Tuesday 22 June

This work is weather dependent and subject to change. We'll keep our website updated if there are any changes to the schedule [www.transport.nsw.gov.au/edmondsonpark](http://www.transport.nsw.gov.au/edmondsonpark).

There may be some noise impacts associated with these out of hours works but every effort will be made to minimise disruption to local residents. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

### Changes to traffic during major concrete pour days

In order to carry out the concrete pours safely, one lane will be closed on Henderson Road adjacent to the work site. Traffic control and signage will be in place to support motorists and pedestrians with the change in traffic arrangements.
