

Commuter Car Park Program **Emu Plains** Project update

Transport for NSW will be delivering a new ground level commuter car park at Emu Plains Station, providing approximately 750 additional parking spaces. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments.

Earlier this year additional Aboriginal Heritage items were discovered during field surveys as part of the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment being undertaken for the project. Additional field work has now been completed with Registered Aboriginal Parties and work to progress the Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment is underway. We'll keep the community informed as this work progresses.

Detailed design - revised car park access

Following community feedback in late 2020 regarding traffic in surrounding streets and vehicle access to the new commuter car park, we are now proposing a roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street. The roundabout will provide entry and exit to the new commuter car park, and will include an additional left turn lane from Old Bathurst Road (southbound direction) into Smith Street. The roundabout is also being designed to accommodate large heavy vehicles including B-double

trucks, and will help improve traffic management and road safety at this intersection.

Footbridge design

The new footbridge will provide safe and convenient pedestrian access between the commuter car park and the station.

The design for the footbridge truss structure has been refined and maintains views and a sense of openness when walking along the bridge. In consultation with key stakeholders we are also investigating pedestrian connections to support public transport users.

We are continuing to work with the Registered Aboriginal Parties on the careful management of Aboriginal Heritage items identified on site. Over the coming months, additional site investigations and detailed design for the new commuter car park will progress. It is anticipated that construction will commence later this year subject to Aboriginal Heritage approvals. We will keep the community updated as the project progresses.
