

Commuter Car Park Program

Emu Plains

Project update

January 2022

Transport for NSW is constructing a new commuter car park at Emu Plains Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments.

The car park, which will be accessed via a new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, will provide approximately 750 additional commuter parking spaces.

Progress update

Since work began in mid-October 2021, work areas have been set up including temporary fencing and facilities. Vegetation has been removed from the car park area. Preparation work in readiness for installation of the new footbridge over Old Bathurst Road has been progressing.

Upcoming construction work

The following work is planned to occur in January:

- earthworks and removing excavated material from the car park site
- work on the existing pedestrian and cycle pathway (that passes underneath the railway line) to allow construction of the new footbridge
- work for the new roundabout on Old Bathurst Road including utility services work.

Equipment to be used will include excavators, mulcher, grader, bulldozers, tipping trucks, jack hammers, piling rig, concrete mixers, service vehicles, and hand tools. Our work will be carried out in line with the current Public Health Orders and a COVID safety plan is in place. All work is subject to weather, site conditions and COVID restrictions, and may change without notice.

Temporary closures of Old Bathurst Road

To allow installation of the new footbridge to take place, the following temporary closures of Old Bathurst Road (including the pedestrian and cycle pathway) are planned for February 2022:


- Subject to approval, the steel footbridge will be delivered to site between 12am and 5am Thursday 10
 February 2022 and Old Bathurst Road is expected to be closed for approximately 15 minutes.

 During this time, traffic control will be in place to direct motorists.
- A full closure of Old Bathurst Road is planned for the weekend of 12-13 February 2022, weather
 permitting. A detour will be in place via Russell Street, and access to north of the railway line will be
 maintained via Smith Street. An indicative map of the detour during the road closure is shown on the
 next page.

Further information will be provided to the community in the February notification.

Standard construction hours

Most of the construction work will occur between 7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, however we may also need to work from 9am to 5pm on Sundays on occasion. These extended construction hours are approved by the NSW Government under special provisions during the COVID pandemic until late March 2022. Work generating high-impact noise such as jackhammering will not be undertaken in the extended hours.
