

Transport Access Program Erskineville Station Upgrade Planning approval received

Planning approval has been granted for the Erskineville Station Upgrade

Erskineville customers are set to benefit with an upgraded station that is accessible to all, following planning approval. Transport for NSW would like to thank the community for their feedback. We received 224 submissions from the community during the public display of the Review of Environmental Factors (REF) between 15 March and 6 April 2021. All submissions received were considered as part of the planning process and have been addressed in the Determination Report.

Key features of the proposed upgrade include:

- A new pedestrian crossing and footbridge at Bridge Street, with lift and stairs connecting the new footbridge with station platforms
- New facilities, including family accessible, and male and female ambulant toilets, an accessible water fountain, bicycle hoops, and canopies at station platforms to provide better weather protection
- A new lift from the existing concourse to Platform 1
- Improvements to CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage, and upgrades to pedestrian pathways throughout the station precinct
- A new accessible parking space and kiss and ride spaces on Bridge Street

What we heard

Feedback received during the public display period showed that the community supported improving accessibility at Erskineville Station. Other key themes that were identified in the feedback include the importance of heritage and cultural values, more connectivity and facilities at Erskineville Station, upgrades to existing areas and footpaths around the station precinct, and additional canopies.

In response to customer feedback, the proposed kiss and ride location on Bridge Street would be further investigated during detailed design, and in consultation with City of Sydney Council.

Detailed design is now underway, with major construction expected to commence mid 2021. We will keep the community up-to-date as more information about the project becomes available.
