

Nightworks continuing from Tuesday 19 October on Glossop Street, St Marys

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is widening the northbound carriageway on Glossop Street from two lanes to three, between Phillip Street and Hobart Street in St Marys. This work will provide a dedicated left turn slip lane to improve access into the rail corridor for maintenance and construction vehicles.

What happens next?

Works will continue to adjust the central median strip on Glossop Street. Work will begin to upgrade the stormwater pipe crossing Glossop Street into Hobart Street (**see map below**). These works will be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and are in line with the current Public Health Orders with a COVIDSafe plan in place.



Work will include:

- Investigating services on the road verge and median strip
- Demolishing the existing median strip and reinstating it with a new one
- Upgrading the footpath and road
- Installing stormwater pipe across Glossop Street into Hobart Street

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to:

- Vacuum excavation truck
- Road-saw
- Bob-cat
- Excavator(s)
- Tipper truck
- Concrete Truck(s)
- Roller(s)
- Water truck(s)

How will the work affect you?

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. This may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

- Work will generate some noise and our team will minimise impacts where possible, including completing noisier activities by 12 midnight
- Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times
- An increase of light vehicles near the work sites
- Minor traffic disruptions with traffic control measures in place

Our work schedule

Work hours will be Monday to Sunday 7am to 6pm. Our night work hours will be Sunday to Thursday nights from 8pm to 5am.

We will continue night work on the central median strip from **Tuesday 19 October**. Stormwater night work will start on **Tuesday 26 October** and continue until **Friday 12 November 2021**. We may require some scheduling flexibility or additional days' work depending on weather conditions and Public Health Orders.
