

# Nightworks continuing on Glossop Street, St Marys from Monday 15 November

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is widening the northbound carriageway on Glossop Street from two lanes to three, between Phillip Street and Hobart Street in St Marys. This work will provide a dedicated left turn slip lane to improve access into the rail corridor for maintenance and construction vehicles.

# What happens next?

Work will continue to upgrade the stormwater pipe across Glossop Street into Hobart Street. When completed, we will construct a new road median on Glossop Street (**see map below**). These works will be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruption and are in line with the current Public Health Orders with a COVIDSafe plan in place.



#### Work will include:

- upgrading the footpath and road
- installing stormwater pipe across Glossop Street into Hobart Street
- constructing a kerb and filling in the median
- temporary lane marking

**Equipment used** for this work includes but is not limited to: a vacuum excavation truck, road-saw, bobcat, excavators, tipper truck, concrete trucks, rollers, and water trucks.

## How will the work affect you?

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. This may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits, and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

- Our work will generate some noise and our team will minimise impacts, where possible, including completing noisier activities by 12 midnight.
- We will maintain access to driveways and buildings at all times.
- There will be an increase of light and construction vehicles near the work sites.
- There will be minor traffic disruptions and traffic control measures will be in place.

### Our work schedule

Work hours will be Monday to Sunday 7am to 6pm. Our night work hours will be Sunday to Thursday nights from 8pm to 5am.

Night work will be carried between **Monday 15 November and Thursday 16 December**. From Monday 15 November to Thursday 25 November work will take place to install a stormwater pipe, and from Tuesday 30 November to Thursday 16 December to complete median construction. No construction work will take place on Friday and Saturday nights. We may require some scheduling flexibility or additional days' work depending on weather conditions and Public Health Orders.
