



# 16 Regional Cities Services Improvement Program

## Greater Nowra Community Consultation Feedback Summary

### The results of your feedback

Over January and February 2021, Transport for NSW invited the community and stakeholders to have their say on the 16 Regional Cities Services Improvement Program, bus service improvements for Greater Nowra.

We have received some great feedback on what matters most to the community and stakeholders.

You told us that regular services, connectivity and journey times are the key issues. You also said you would like to see more frequent services, and more information about how we will improve bus services.

You have told us that you want a better public transport system and we are committed to delivering this for Greater Nowra.

Your feedback will be used to develop and refine the new bus plan for your local area. We will review and consider all feedback very closely.

We will continue this conversation with the community and stakeholders as we get on and deliver these improvements for Greater Nowra.

### Themes that emerged

- Provide regular and frequent services (eg. Sanctuary Point, Bay & Basin, Sussex Inlet & Vincentia areas)
- More bus services to connect to train services
- Shorter journey times
- Provide services at a reasonable cost
- Access to TAFE

In response to themes raised in the feedback, we will develop the bus network plan with an increased awareness of the local issues and needs.

We will identify all potential service improvement opportunities from the community feedback, which will be considered as part of the planning process to develop the final bus plan. We will continue to work closely with our stakeholders to address the needs and issues raised by the community, to support the growing and changing population of Greater Nowra.

## Other matters

A number of feedback items related to topics outside the scope of the 16 Regional Cities Services Improvement Program for Greater Nowra.

Where issues not related specifically to the program were raised, these matters have been referred to relevant areas within Transport for NSW or the appropriate agencies within the NSW Government.

## Next steps

We are currently investigating a number of issues, needs and opportunities identified by the community and stakeholders. This includes working closely with Shoalhaven City Council around options for bus zones and parking.

Following an extensive review of all of the feedback that we have received, a new improved bus network plan is aimed to be delivered in 2022.

The new bus network will ensure that Greater Nowra has the transport services it needs to grow and prosper in the future.

We will keep you informed as we come closer to introducing the new bus network and thank you for your contribution through the community consultation process.
