



Transport for NSW is delivering the Hornsby Commuter Car Park with up to 140 parking spaces to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and to help ease the congestion on our roads.

Design and Construct contract awarded

Transport for NSW has awarded the design and construct contract to the Australian Building Construction Company (ADCO). ADCO will commence the detailed design and later the work.

- provision for future electric vehicle charging spaces
- Transport Park and Ride infrastructure (Opal operated boom gates)
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinder signs for improved safety and security
- landscaping within the car park.

What's planned?

The Hornsby Commuter Car Park on Jersey Street will feature:

- a new at-grade commuter car park with around 140 parking spaces
- entry and exit to the car park from Jersey Street
- additional accessible parking spaces provided
- dedicated pathways connecting to the existing footpath along Jersey Street

Next Steps

Work will start on the preparation of a detailed design. Studies will be done on how the work can be carried out and impacts managed. Consultation will be carried out with Hornsby Shire Council and the community.

Work will start in February 2022 and is expected to be completed by late 2022.

Landscaping

Some existing trees in and around the car park site will need to be trimmed or removed as part of the work. We understand that the existing trees contribute to the vibrancy of the area and we aim to retain trees where possible, including two identified *Eucalyptus saligna* "Blue Gums".

To offset tree removal, we will work with Hornsby Shire Council on options to offset vegetation.
