- ✓ a new lift connecting the footbridge to Platform 2

- ✓ upgrades to the ramp from the commuter car park to the pedestrian footbridge
- √ a new station entrance to Platform 1
- ✓ accessibility upgrades to the platform waiting room
- √ upgrades to station pathways, stairs and platforms
- ✓ upgrades to CCTV, lighting and signage.
